Responsibilities

- Transport clients in your vehicle and accompany clients in accessible vehicles
- Assisting with arranging and picking up groceries, medical equipment, and prescriptions
- Perform housekeeping tasks
- Provide personal care
- Provide respite care for caregivers and activation for clients
- Effectively communicate with clients, caregivers, healthcare professionals, and other partners
- Ability to take initiative and approach all situations with a positive attitude
- Be available on-call for assignments a minimum of 3 weekdays between 8:30 am-4:30 pm

Qualifications

- Personal Support Worker Certificate or acceptable equivalent (e.g. RPN, RN)
- Experience working with older adults in a community setting
- Current First Aid & CPR Certificates
- Valid Ontario Driver's License and auto insurance
- Access to a suitable vehicle for the purpose of transporting clients
- 3-year uncertified Driver Record from Service Ontario
- Ability to accept assignments on short notice across the City and County of Peterborough
- Police Vulnerable Sector Check
- Use of a personal cell phone (data plan not required)
- High speed internet access at home or on smartphone for sending reports each work day
