A 'smiles all around' event organized by Community Care Peterborough





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



We would like students to submit both a hand-drawn picture of themselves with their nominee as well as a piece of writing that answers some of the following questions:

- What is important about your relationship with your Grandparent, Elder or special older person?
- What kinds of activities do you enjoy together?
- What kind of knowledge have they shared with you?
- Describe a happy occasion you shared together.









Optional: Students can submit a recorded video of them reading their story.

This is not required, and will not affect judging.

We accept entries in both English and French. A committee will select one winner and one honourable mention from each group of grades; primary and junior. Primary is Grades 2 & 3. Junior is Grades 4, 5, & 6.
