Program and Office Status – March 24th, 2020

Program Status

We are committed to our part in limiting the spread of the COVID - 19 and working closely with Peterborough Public Health. Our program status has been updated since March 20th, 2020 and the changes in summary are:

- As of March 24th, 2020:
 - Home Help and Home Maintenance Program is officially suspended.
 - Brokered Helpers will contact their clients to cancel any planned visits.
 - Brokered Helpers will advise us of any clients they would deem as high-risk without the support of Brokered Services. An example may be clients who rely on Brokered Home Help for groceries and does not have family, friends, or neighbours to assist with this essential activity.
 - Strategies to support these high-risk clients will be developed by our staff on a case by case basis to ensure their safety.
 - o Home First is moved to green column
 - Enhanced Care Coordinator who is typically based out of PRHC is working remotely to support patients being discharged from hospital.
 - Supported Referral Coordination moved to green column
 - Coordinator who is typically based out of the Central East LHIN Home and Community Care office is working remotely to support referrals across the region.
