Clients on the High Intensity Supports at Home (HISH) program caseload have complex care needs and are typically on the crisis waitlist for long term care. Home Support Workers assist HISH clients with routine household activities. Duties vary according to the individual needs of the client but may include grocery shopping, light housekeeping, and meal preparation. HSWs are required to complete electronic documentation following each assignment.

Qualifications & Experience

- High school diploma, GED, or an equivalent combination of work experience and education.
- Minimum of 1 years' experience in a housekeeping role is preferred.
- Experience working with older adults or adults with physical challenges.
- Ability to commit to a regular schedule and provide punctual, reliable service.
- Valid Ontario Driver's License, auto insurance, and access to a vehicle suitable.
- The physical strength and ability to undertake frequent walking, bending, stretching, pulling, and long periods of standing. Able to comfortably lift 40lbs without risk of injury.
- High speed internet access at home <u>OR</u> on smartphone for receiving assignments and sending reports.
- Satisfactory Police Vulnerable Sector Check.
- Proof of full COVID-19 immunization (where medically able in accordance with CCP's COVID-19 Vaccination policy)
