In 2018 the Community Care Peterborough Volunteer Transportation Team, made up of 66 volunteers, drove more than 800 clients to medical appointments, dialysis treatments, hair appointments, social activities and grocery shopping. This group combined to provide 31,768 volunteer hours! Their contribution to their community was recognized in June 2019 at the City of Peterborough's Civic Awards. This team of drivers are compassionate, reliable and dedicated individuals who are extremely worthy of the 2018 Civic Award for Community Betterment. We celebrated hitting really big numbers, once again, as we delivered much-needed services to 7,247 seniors & those living with physical challenges.

Powered by a team of 830 volunteers and 160 brokered helpers, providing over 112,600 hours of service last year – 61 full time equivalent postitions – we:



Delivered 37,777 meals through our Meals on Wheels program.







Completed 28,044 reassurance calls and visits to individuals living alone.

Installed 581 personal distress alarms to keep people safe in their homes.





Helped 707 individuals settle back into their home after a hospital stay through our Home at Last program.

Serving the City & County of Peterborough

Accessible transportation is based on the availability of drivers and/or other resources. Flat rate fees apply based on the distance travelled. Attendants ride fee of charge.

Last year our Community Care Van provided 1,036 drives and our Caremobiles provided 1,000. Combined we have over 200 clients registered for our Specialized Transportation.

Caremobile, Bus 1 & 2 serving the County of Peterborough

Trained staff provide door to door service to offer fully accessible transportation to residents living in the County of Peterborough. Service is available to individuals with physical challenges who cannot access conventional transportation.


